

COVID Safety Acknowledgment

Consistent with CDC guidelines, Spectrum Singers is implementing certain preventative measures to reduce the spread of COVID-19. However, Spectrum Singers cannot guarantee that its participants, volunteers, or others in attendance will not become infected with COVID-19. Please be advised that by attending Spectrum Singers rehearsals, you may come intact with the COVID-19. 1. We are requiring that all participants be fully vaccinated and recommend that participants be as fully boosted as possible with one of the vaccines approved for use in the United States. If you are not fully boosted, please be aware that your risk of contracting COVID-19 and getting severe symptoms is likely much higher.
2. We recommend, but do not require, that masks be worn when possible. Masks are an efficient way of decreasing some (thought certainly not all) of the risk of transmission.
 - a. We will be providing masks for any participant who would like one and does not have one.
3. We ask that any time a participant is experiencing illness, or if they have been exposed to COVID, that they stay home from rehearsal that week, and instead listen and participate in the Zoom recordings if at all possible.
4. We recommend participants be mindful of social distancing. We will be using a color coded sticker system: green=the person feels comfortable being in close proximity to another person with a green sticker; yellow=the person is cautious about being in close proximity, please ask before hugging or being within 3 feet of them; red=please do not get physically close to the person and instead engage in conversation from about a 6-foot distance.
5. If you are immunocompromised to the extent that you are unable to attend rehearsals with maskless individuals, we are very sad that you will not be able to join us in-person (as we anticipate that some individuals at rehearsals will be unmasked). You are welcome to attend rehearsals virtually, but, unfortunately, you will not be able to participate in concerts in the regular way. If interested, you might be able to participate in other ways, such as reading text for the program or volunteering with various aspects of organizational activities.

Participation includes possible exposure to and illness from infectious diseases including but not limited to COVID-19. While particular rules and personal discipline may reduce this risk, the risk of serious illness and death does exist.
